In song, dance and spoken word, we explore the power of transformation when we surrender to the inevitability of change. We follow Persephone as she ascends from the Underworld where she has spent Winter. In the modern retelling of this ageless story Persephone is met by Baubo who guides her through the change required of her when she returns at spring and the Earth is once again fertile with fruit and grains. Persephone makes this great change each year so that humanity thrives. But does she really like it? Do any of us like the changes that are given us to make?



We acknowledge that change is inevitable and not always of our own choosing. We celebrate Persephone and the Earth's constant renewal while exploring how to accept, embrace, and integrate the changes we must make into our lives.
